WHAT YOUR COUNTY IS DOING TO HELP

During this crisis, your County government is dedicated to ensuring residents' safety, and to helping residents restore their homes, property, security, peace of mind and quality of life.

The County of San Diego serves nearly three million residents spread over nearly 4,000 square miles. Roughly half a million of these residents live in the County's unincorporated area. The remainder of the population resides in the County's 18 incorporated cities. To provide vital services during this crisis, the County is working closely with other local jurisdictions, State and federal agencies, and a number of charitable and community service organizations. - The County will waive all building permit fees
- Damage Assessment Teams are in the field assessing damages
- "Head of the line" permit service
- Priority building inspections as you rebuild
- Free Emergency Temporary Occupancy Permit during rebuild
- Extra staff to help you through the process

Rebuilding your lost or damaged home	If your home has been destroyed or damaged by fire, the County will provide fee waivers and expedited services to help you rebuild.	858-495-5483
Reclaiming large animals/livestock	Large animals and livestock will be held for an extended period at temporary emergency shelters.	619-767-2675
