

WHAT YOUR COUNTY IS DOING TO HELP

During this crisis, your County government is dedicated to ensuring residents' safety, and to helping residents restore their homes, property, security, peace of mind and quality of life.

The County of San Diego serves nearly three million residents spread over nearly 4,000 square miles. Roughly half a million of these residents live in the County's unincorporated area. The remainder of the population resides in the County's 18 incorporated cities. To provide vital services during this crisis, the County is working closely with other local jurisdictions, State and federal agencies, and a number of charitable and community service organizations.
